Technology will be integrated in all aspects of the experience, audio, video etc. along with the ability to interface with cell phones. Art will be rotated in and out to maintain relevance and attractiveness.

The museum would be multifunctional, in that it would provide family entertainment, genealogy research, poetry slams, healing space and networking opportunities for millennia's and generation Z.

In addition, there will be a gift shop on site to commemorate the experience e.g., t-shirts, souvenirs, dashikis, hats, books, videos, whatnots, gadgets etc.

### Lconomic Developmen
